



2025-2026 Fall Semester Exam Schedule

A fall exam can be either a semester final exam or a Quarterly Summative Exam (QSE) for Quarter 2. Please refer to pages 68 and 90 of the [Student Handbook](#) for information on which courses are eligible for exemption as well as which courses have either a final or a QSE.

All examinations must be given according to the established schedule and none are to be given early. Full-year classes are NOT eligible for fall final exam exemptions. ONLY fall semester classes may be exempt at this time.

December 12th & December 15th are review days. No new grades are to be given on these days.

FINAL EXAM EXEMPTIONS

Full year courses are NOT eligible for exemptions until the spring semester.

OPEN CAMPUS

So, what exactly does Open Campus mean?

- If you are exempt, AND DO NOT NEED TO ATTEND THAT FINAL DUE TO BEING EXEMPT, you do not have to be present in that class during that time. **Full year classes are NOT eligible for exemptions for the fall final exam. ONLY semester classes can be exempt.**
 - But wait! That doesn't mean you can leave and come back. If you are exempt and need to sit for a class or final exam later that day, you may arrive late, or sit in your assigned class and do a quiet activity such as reading ONLY. All other areas are prohibited (ex: cafeteria, flex spaces, hallways, gyms, going to Starbucks, etc.)
 - There are no early dismissals during a final exam period. Students must remain in class until the dismissal bell rings.
- Do you ride the bus? No worries, they still will run at their normal time, except on early release days. On early release days, buses will roll at 11:20 am. If you are exempt, AND ride the bus, you must attend your classes as scheduled.
